 - i. Broadhead Sewer Separation Project Update The Borough has cost estimates for three scenarios on each portion of the project, full reconstruction, a value option, and full brick reconstruction. In order to provide a more nuanced choice our engineers are working on developing estimates for a hybrid solution for some of the portions. Those four options will be shared with Council and the Public at a Council Meeting in June.
 - ii. Transfer of Trunk Lines authorizing the transfer agreement of the C-19 and C-20 intermunicipal trunk lines to ALCOSAN. This is a process that began more than 15 years ago with 3 Rivers Wet Weather, CONNECT, and ALCOSAN working together to move these assets/liabilities from individual municipalities to ALCOSAN who is better positioned to manage them. Our Engineer will provide more background.

- iii. 2023 Road Paving Update & Next Steps
 - 1. 2023 Paving Program 5 bids were opened on April 27, 2023 for the 2023 Road Paving Program. The low bidder was El Grande Industries with a base bid of \$289,356.25 and Add Alternate (Fountain Street) in the

amount of \$114,760.00. The Base Bid was estimated at \$306K and the Add Alternate at \$124K. The Borough has budgeted \$320K for 2023 Road Program.

MOTION: award the 2023 Paving Program base bid to El Grande Industries in the amount of \$289,356.25 per the <u>recommendation of Gateway Engineers</u>.

- iv. Union Avenue Reconstruction The contractor, TA Robinson, has started on the base removal and construction for the first portion of the Union, and paving for the first section will be completed at the end of this week or early next. The second phase will begin immediately after.
- v. Crafton Blvd Streetscape Phase II Lights are on order. There were two mistaken deliveries (wrong lights) and they are awaiting the third and final delivery.
- vi. Multi Municipal Zoning Project Update ZoneCo will be creating a website to provide a place for feedback and we are looking for new avenues to communicate public engagement opportunities.
- i. Pool House Update The pool house project is in its final design stage and we are planning to present that to Council in June. The original cost estimate for the project was approximately \$780K after inflation was considered. And it was decided to remove replacing the roof as part of the project since the Borough had received a grant offset of \$250K. This brought the cost down to approximately \$580K. There is concern that the roof will still need to be replaced.
