a. Allegheny County Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG) and HOME Investment Partnerships programs – The Community Development Block Grant Program includes funding for public improvements like water and sewer, demolition, recreation, and general infrastructure. The HOME Investment Partnership Program is a federal funding source managed by the County to assist in the construction or repair of affordable housing. To be eligible to participate in these County programs the Borough is required to pass a resolution.

- c. Resolution 2023-19 Declaring the Borough's intent to enter into a financial agreement with Huntington Public Capital Corporation to finance a 2023 Ford F550 Chassis Cab and dump body with a snow plow dump truck in the amount of \$112,852

MOTION: To approve Resolution 2023-19 declaring the Borough's intent to enter a financial agreement with Huntington Public Capital Corporation in the amount of \$112,852.

d. Zoning Hearing Board Case regarding 1950 Crafton Blvd. The property owner sought a variance from the Zoning Hearing Board regarding their hedges and vision requirements in the Borough Code. The ZHB asked that the property owner work with the Borough to find an equitable solution before the ZHB board meets again at the end of September. Three options were explored, a traffic mirror, changing Johnston to a one-way street, and cutting down and/or moving the hedges. The first option (mirrors) is not acceptable to the Borough, the third option (alter hedges) is not preferred by the property owner, so that leaves the second option (changing Johnston Street to one way).

MOTION: To approve the Borough Administration to work with the property owner in determining the feasibility of making Johston Street a one-way street. The property owner will be responsible for obtaining a traffic study to support the change and must obtain signatures from at least 70 percent of the property owners on Harrison and Johnston Streets. All costs will be borne by the property owner. If those requirements are met, the Borough will seek to pass and ordinance changing the traffic pattern to one-way on Johnston Street.

That combined with inflation has led to an estimate of \$1.1 million which is \$550,000 higher than the initial estimate of \$565,000. We are looking into options that will bring the estimate closer to the original.
