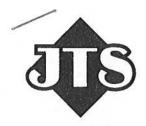

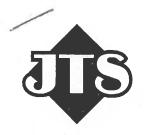

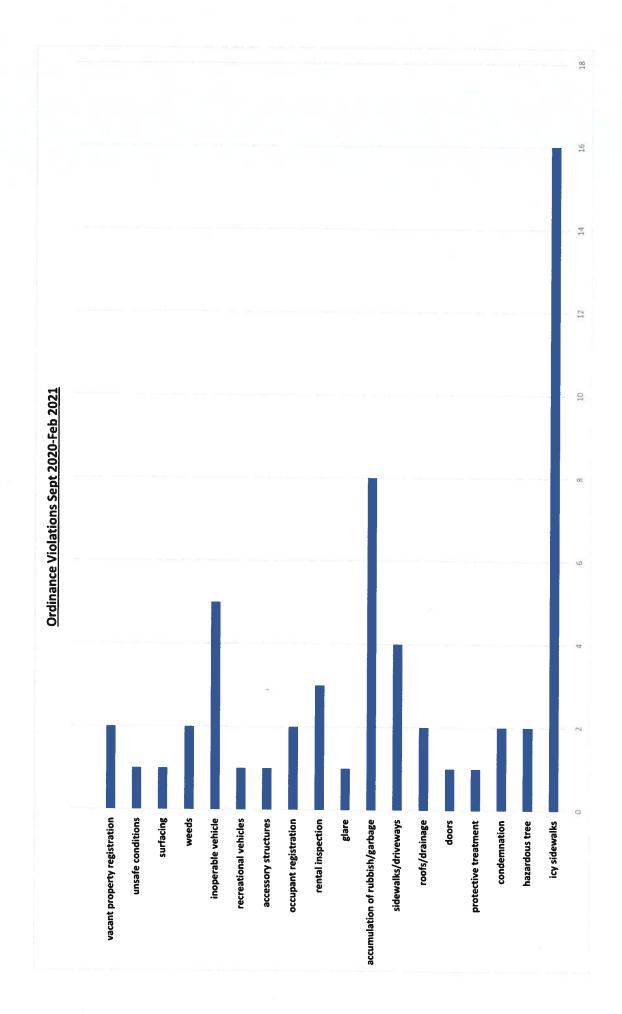

<u>Code Enforcement Report Summary for October 2020 – February 2021</u>

- I've spent a good deal of my time dealing with vacant properties on many levels be it with condemnations, trying to get them into new hands via sheriffs sales, or getting them registered or making certain they are secured.
- A good example of securing properties would be 64 S Grandview where I had to take an officer to check and see if a squatter was in it and then secure it.
- We have had a few vacant properties sell at Sheriffs sale and flippers are already at work. One on Fountain and one on Dinsmore.
- We need to do more as a borough to get movement on vacant properties while our market is hot and we have flippers and buyers.
- I have also spent a good deal of the last months going through our entire file of tenant registration files and cross-referencing them to their street files and Traisr to make a master list of rentals and their registration and inspection statuses. To date no one has ever attempted this in this way. This has implications for tax collection, fee collection, but most importantly to me-- the safety of all residents who rent in Crafton. So far I'd say three-quarters of all rentals are not up-to-date for inspections and registrations.
- Once I have the data we will need to start sending notices and hopefully use Traisr going forward to keep track of everything.
- This is where I think a second code officer would be good. One of us could do field work, and I would do some field work but mainly all the administrative stuff—specifically getting this rental issue in order.
- This last month (February) I have been out enforcing the sidewalk/snow ordinance first with placing 50+ fliers on doors that simply stated the ordinance and to clear their sidewalk. That solves about 97% of the population that needs reminding. The other 3% were followed up with citations. I issued over 10 citations just this week for icy sidewalks.

- All my hearings keep getting pushed back. I have not been in court since November I think at this point. I won't have anything now until next month and April. They might even reschedule again.
- I wrote a citation, for instance, for the RV at Big Daddys Donuts on Nov 6th and we have been rescheduled 2 times and are now scheduled for April. I began communication about it with the owner in August of 2020.
