At its regular meeting to be held on Monday, October 28, 2019 at 7:15 p.m., in Council Chambers at the Crafton Borough Building and Community Center, 100 Stotz Avenue, Crafton, PA 15205, the Council of the Borough of Crafton will consider the adoption of, and if appropriate enact, a proposed ordinance as follows:

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF CRAFTON, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TO ENTER INTO A TEMPORARY LICENSE AND COOPERATION AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF PITTSBURGH FOR THE PURPOSE OF PAVING INGRAM AVENUE BETWEEN DUNCAN AVENUE AND STEUBEN STREET AND APPORTIONING THE COST OF SAME.

This proposed ordinance authorizes the Borough to enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement with the City of Pittsburgh to pave Ingram Avenue between Duncan Avenue and Steuben Street and apportions costs for same.
